
WHAT IS FIBROMYALGIA?

Fibromyalgia is a disorder causing aches, pains, and "tender points" all over the body. The disorder affects millions of Americans, but 80 to 90 percent of those affected are women. The symptoms can range from mild discomfort and ache to widespread, chronic pain and fatigue. Other symptoms can include joint stiffness and pain, musculoskeletal pain, sensitivity, anxiety, depression, and memory impairment. Unfortunately, fibromyalgia is still very much a mystery making it difficult to diagnose and treat.

TREATMENT

There is no known cure for fibromyalgia; however, patients may find relief through a variety of different therapies such as pain medications, anti-seizure drugs, antidepressants, psychotherapy, hormone therapy and stress reduction. Nutrition also plays an important role in the treatment of fibromyalgia. Whole grains are much better than processed foods like white flour, white rice, and refined sugar. Dietary supplements like vitamin C, magnesium, vitamin B-12, and folic acid my be helpful in reducing fatigue.
